

Getting Your First Page Live on WordPress

Using GoDaddy Domain + Hostinger Hosting + Gutenberg + Essential Blocks

1. Buy a Domain on GoDaddy on a Registrar/Domain Seller of your choice

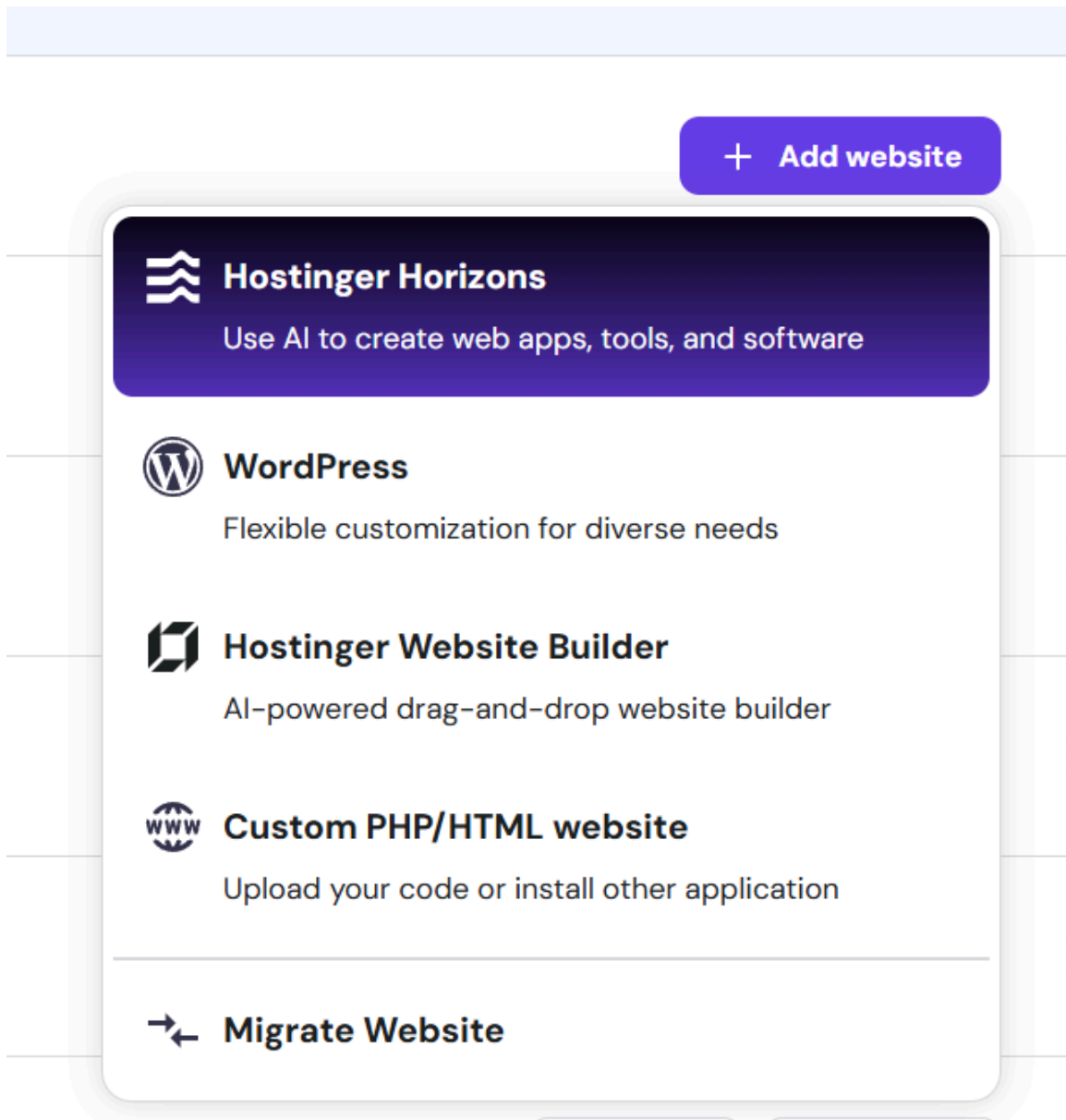
- Go to <https://www.godaddy.com>
 - Search and purchase your domain.
 - Access your domain dashboard under “My Products”.

2. Purchase Hosting on Hostinger or a hosting service seller of your choice

- Visit <https://www.hostinger.in>
 - Choose a hosting plan.
 - Complete payment and log in to Hostinger’s hPanel.

3. Add Domain in Hostinger (Plain PHP Site First)

- In your Hostinger dashboard, go to **Websites > Website List > Add Website**
- Choose Custom PHP/HTML website



- Enter the domain name you bought from GoDaddy
- Choose the option, **I already own a domain**

Claim your free domain, buy a new one, or confirm a domain you already own. You can also create a free subdomain for any published website.



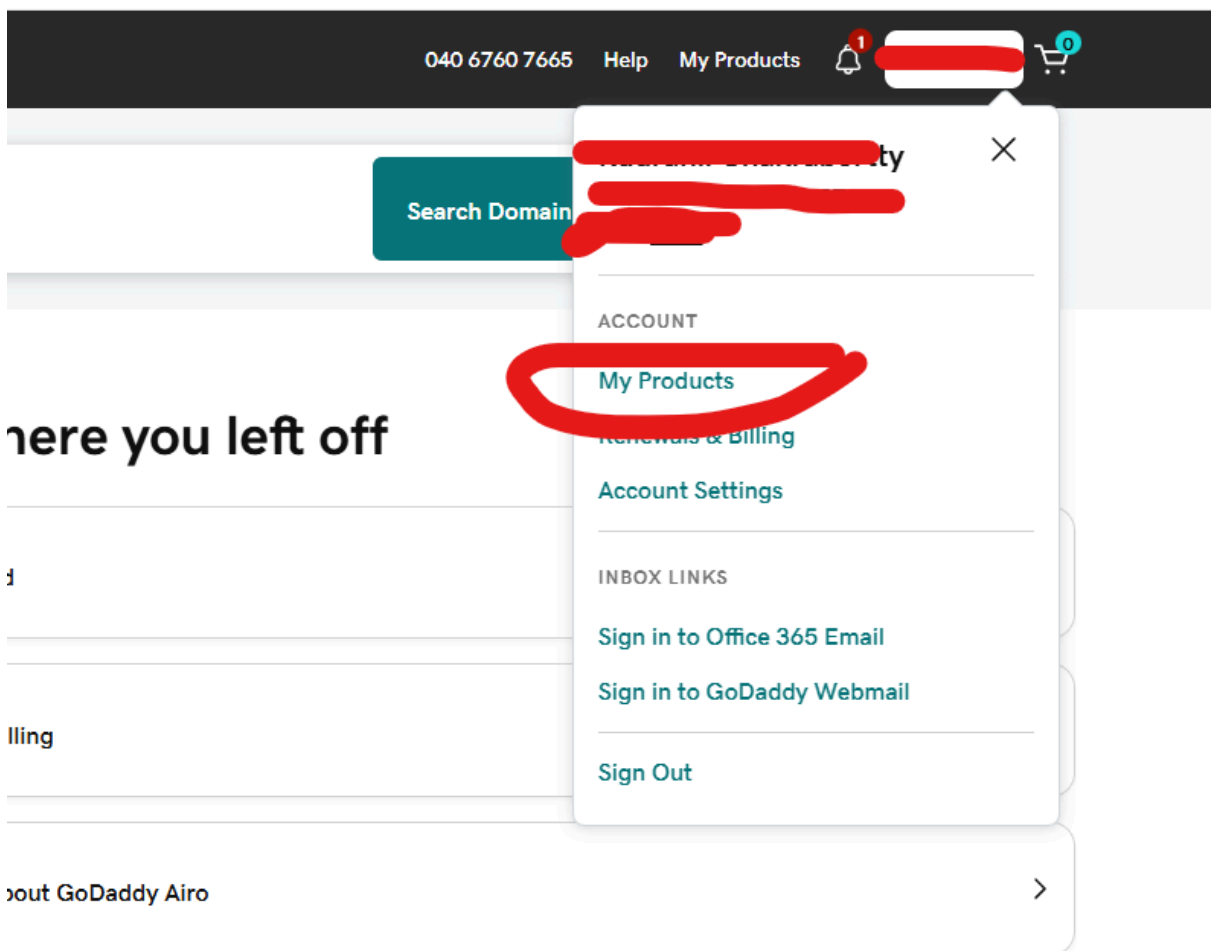
- Hostinger will now show you the **nameservers** you need to update in GoDaddy

- For Hostinger it is always the below nameservers (you can use these as-is):

- ns1.dns-parking.com
- ns2.dns-parking.com

4. Update Nameservers on GoDaddy

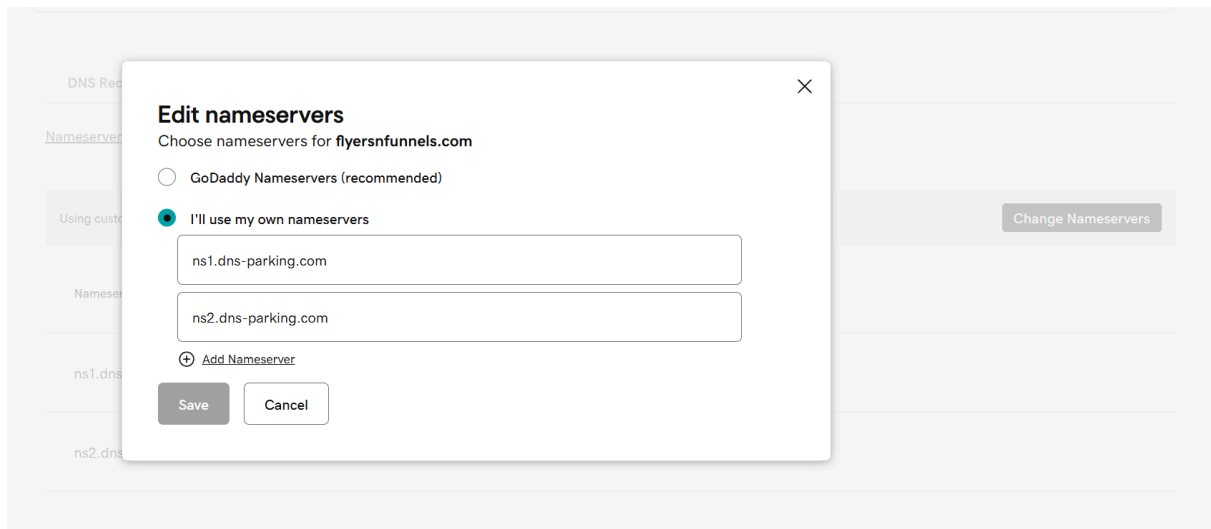
- Go to your GoDaddy account
- Under “My Products,” find the domain you want to connect



- Click **DNS**



- In the **Nameservers** section, click **Change**
- Choose **Custom** > Paste Hostinger's nameservers (**ns1...** , **ns2...**)



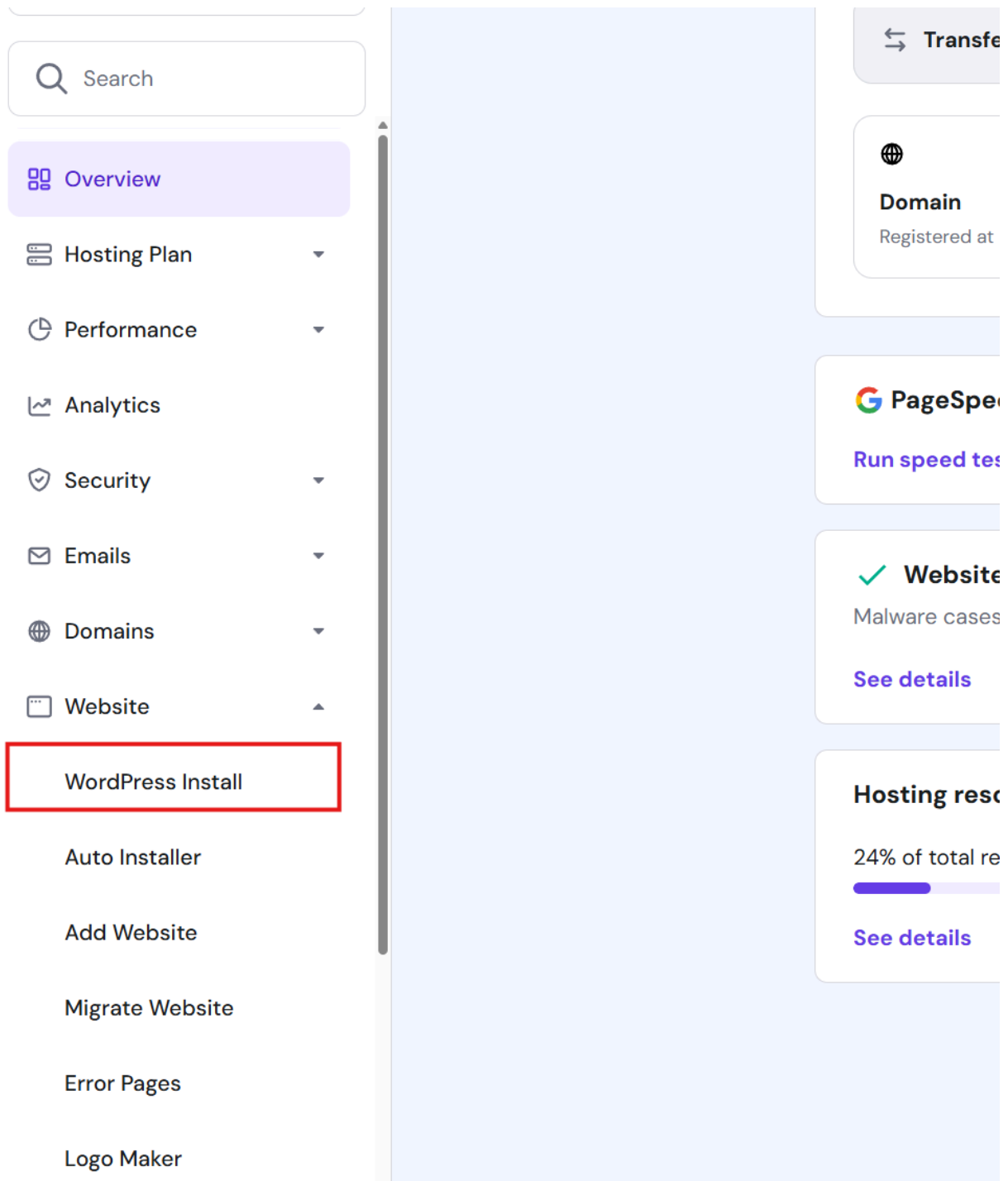
- Save changes
- Domain linking may take 15 minutes to 24-48 hours

5. Install WordPress on Hostinger

- Go back to your Hostinger **Websites** dashboard
- Click **Dashboard** next to your newly added domain



- Under the **Website** section, select **WordPress Install**

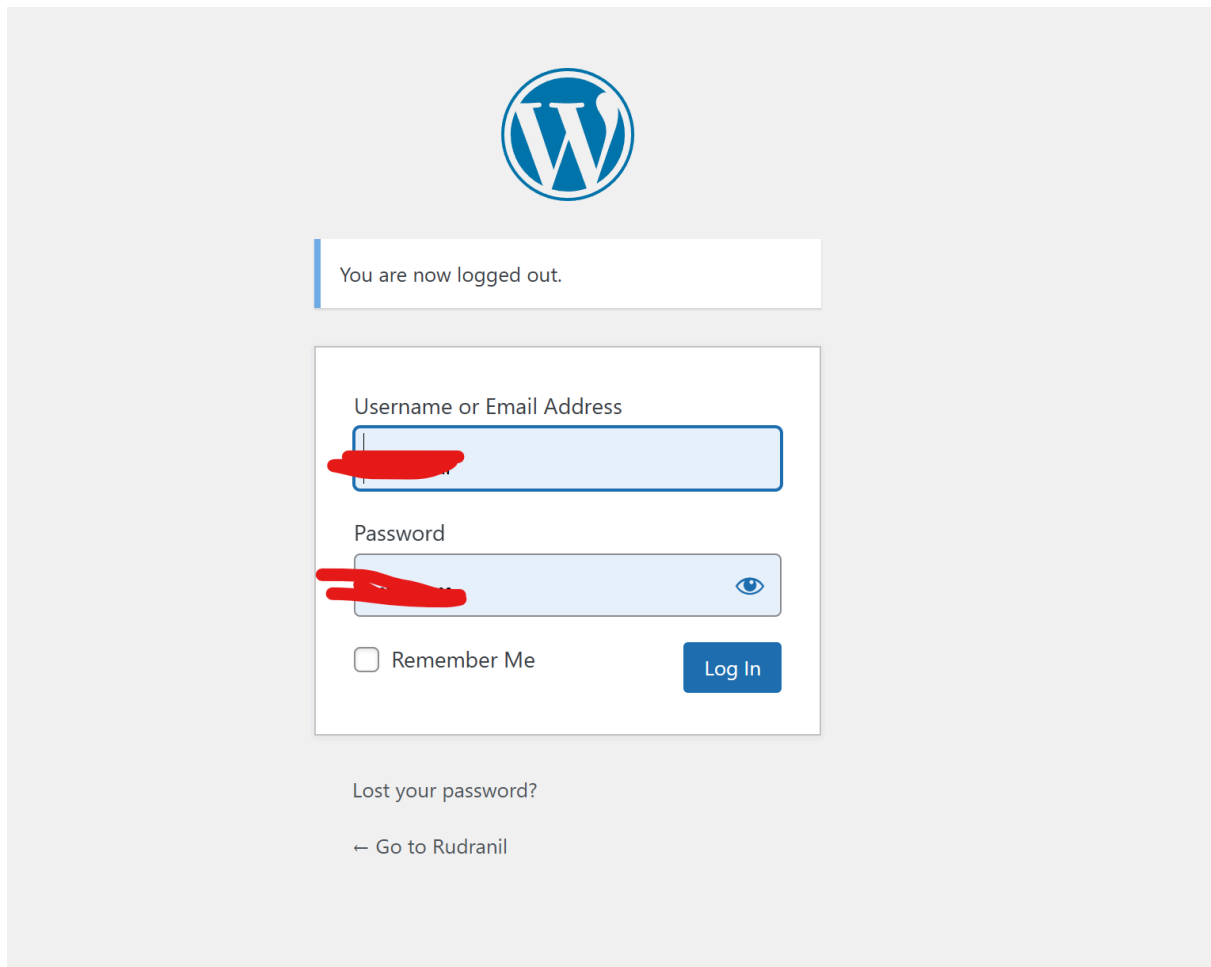


- Choose **WordPress** and click **Install**
- Fill out:
 - Website Title
 - Admin username & password
 - Admin email
- Click **Install**

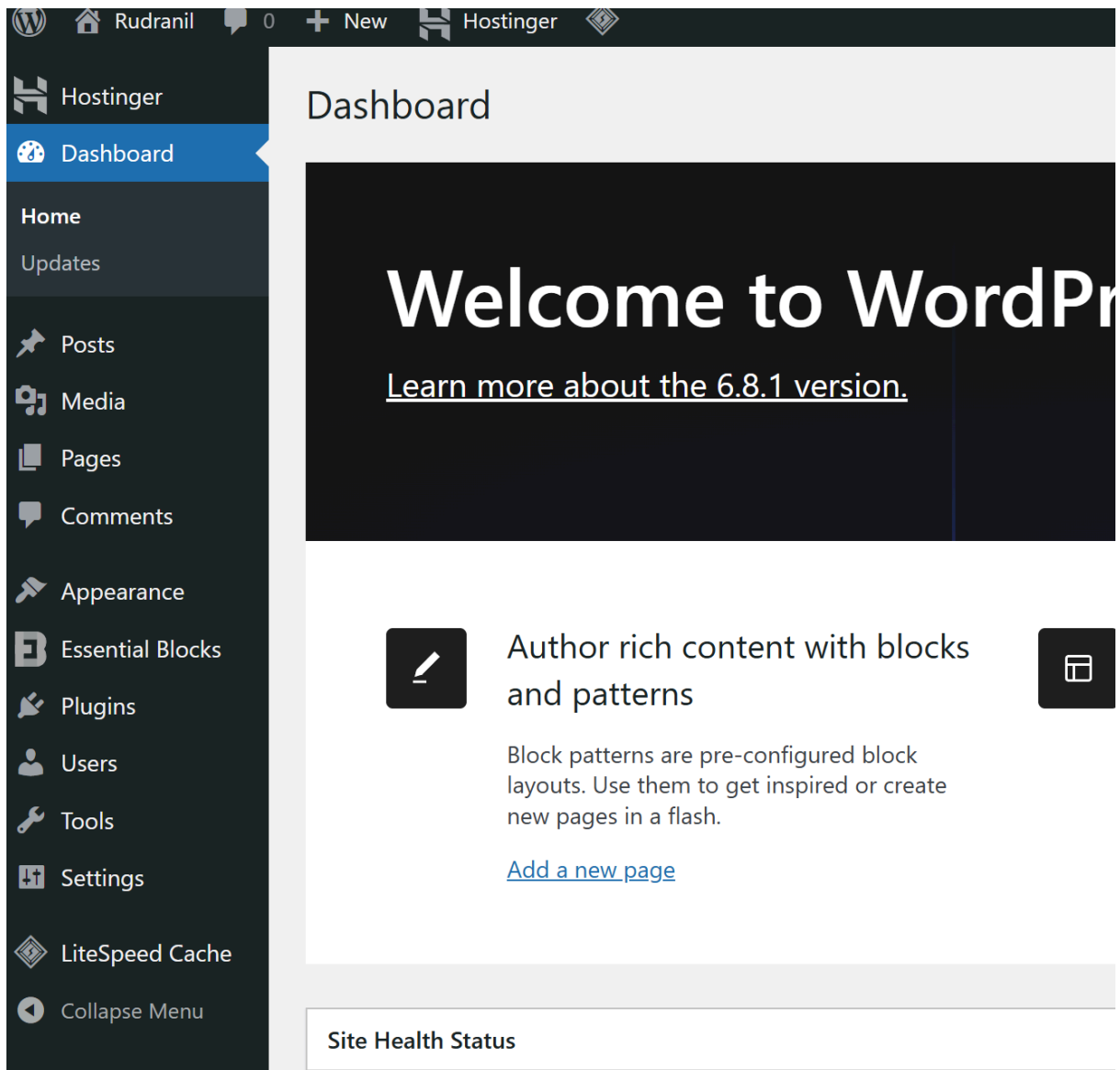
- Save your admin login URL (<https://yourdomain.com/wp-admin>)

6. Log in to WordPress Admin Dashboard

- Open the admin URL in your browser
- Log in with your credentials

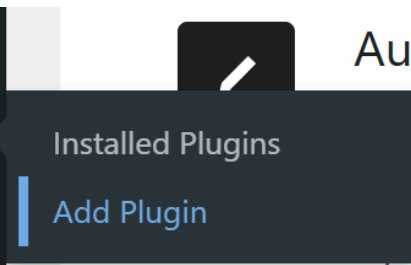
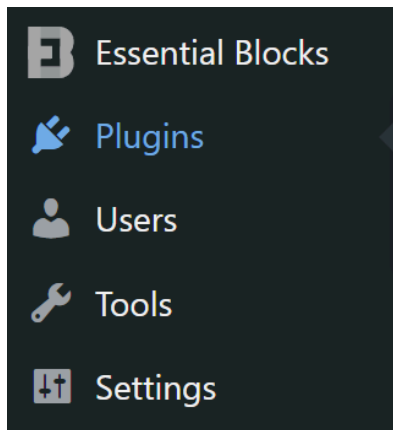


- You're now inside the WordPress dashboard



7. 📦 Install Essential Blocks for Gutenberg

- Go to **Plugins > Add New**

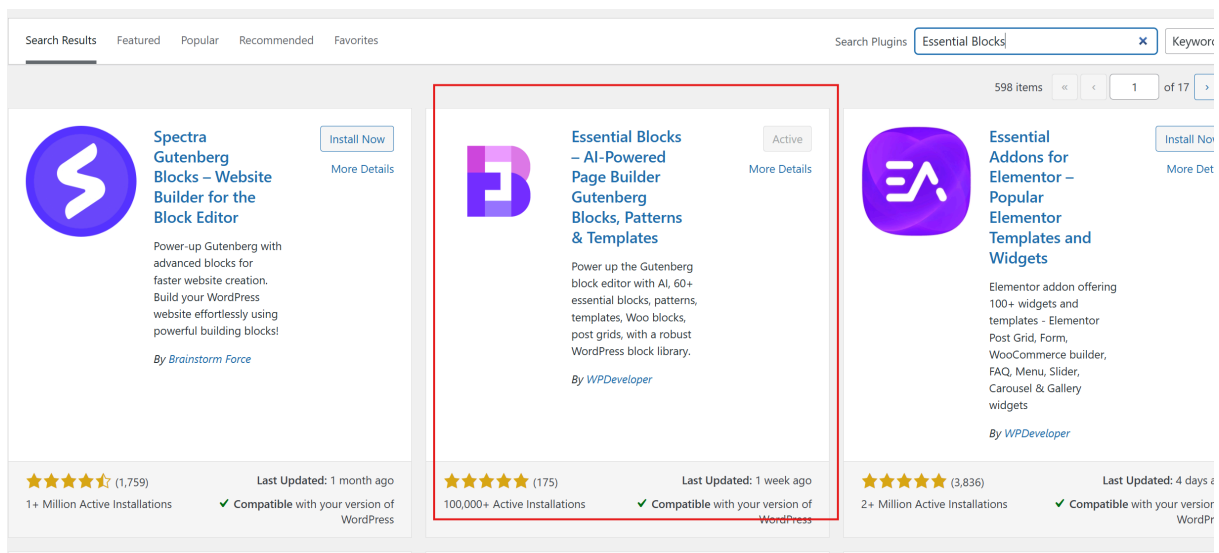

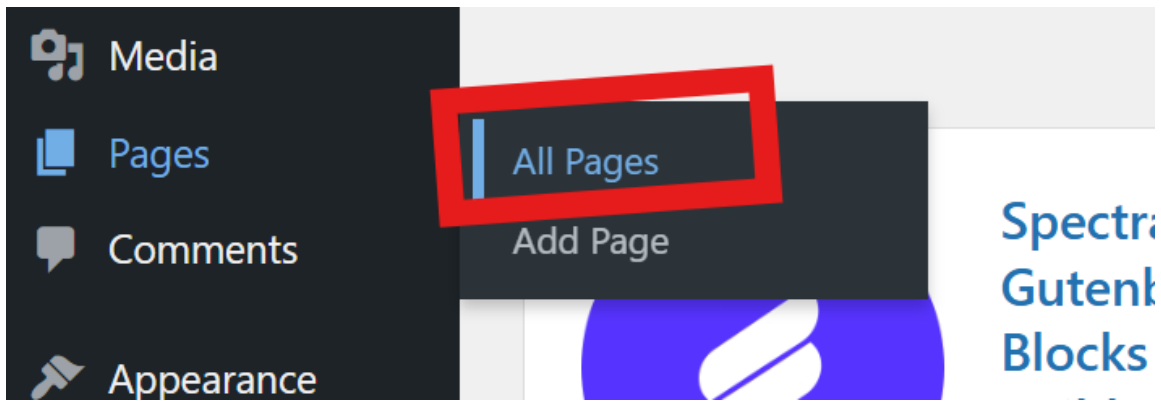
- Search for “Essential Blocks for Gutenberg”
- Click **Install Now** → **Activate**



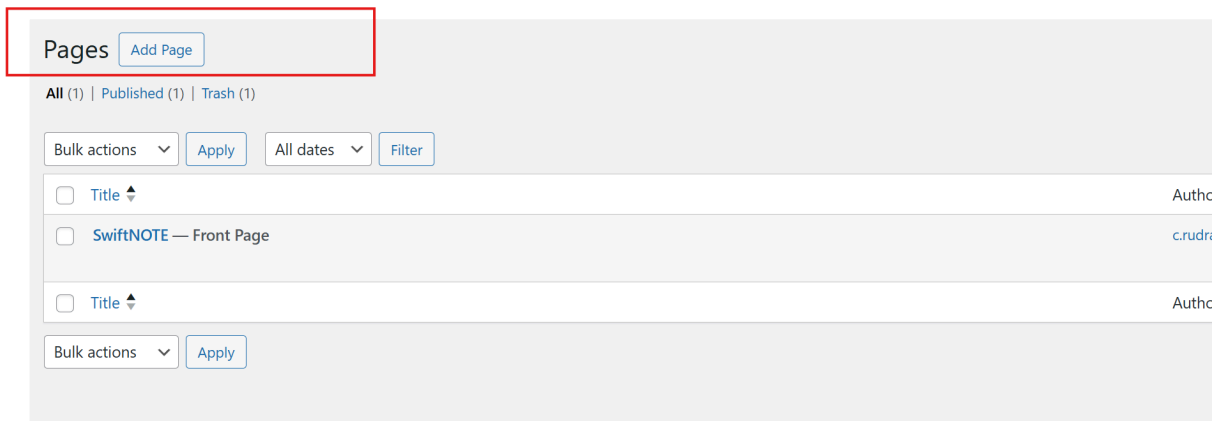
- This plugin unlocks powerful design blocks for easy page creation.

8. Create and Design Your First Page

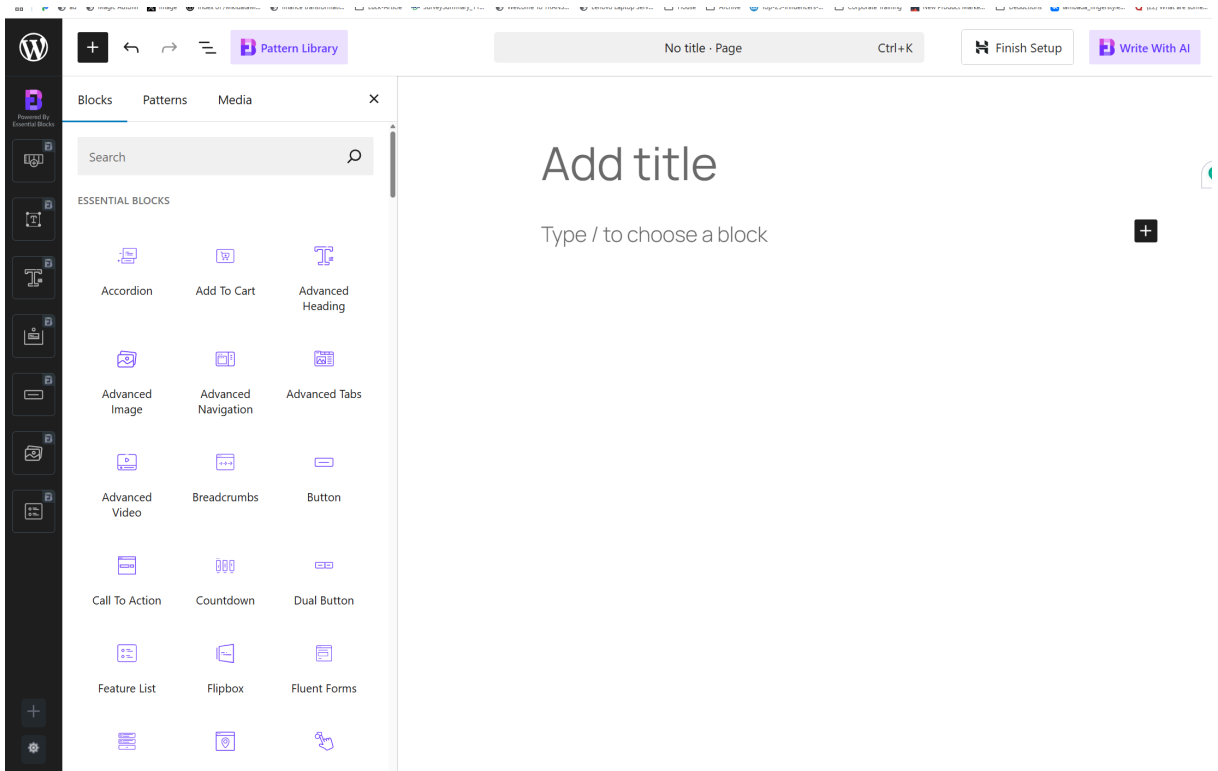
- Go to **Pages**



- Add Page

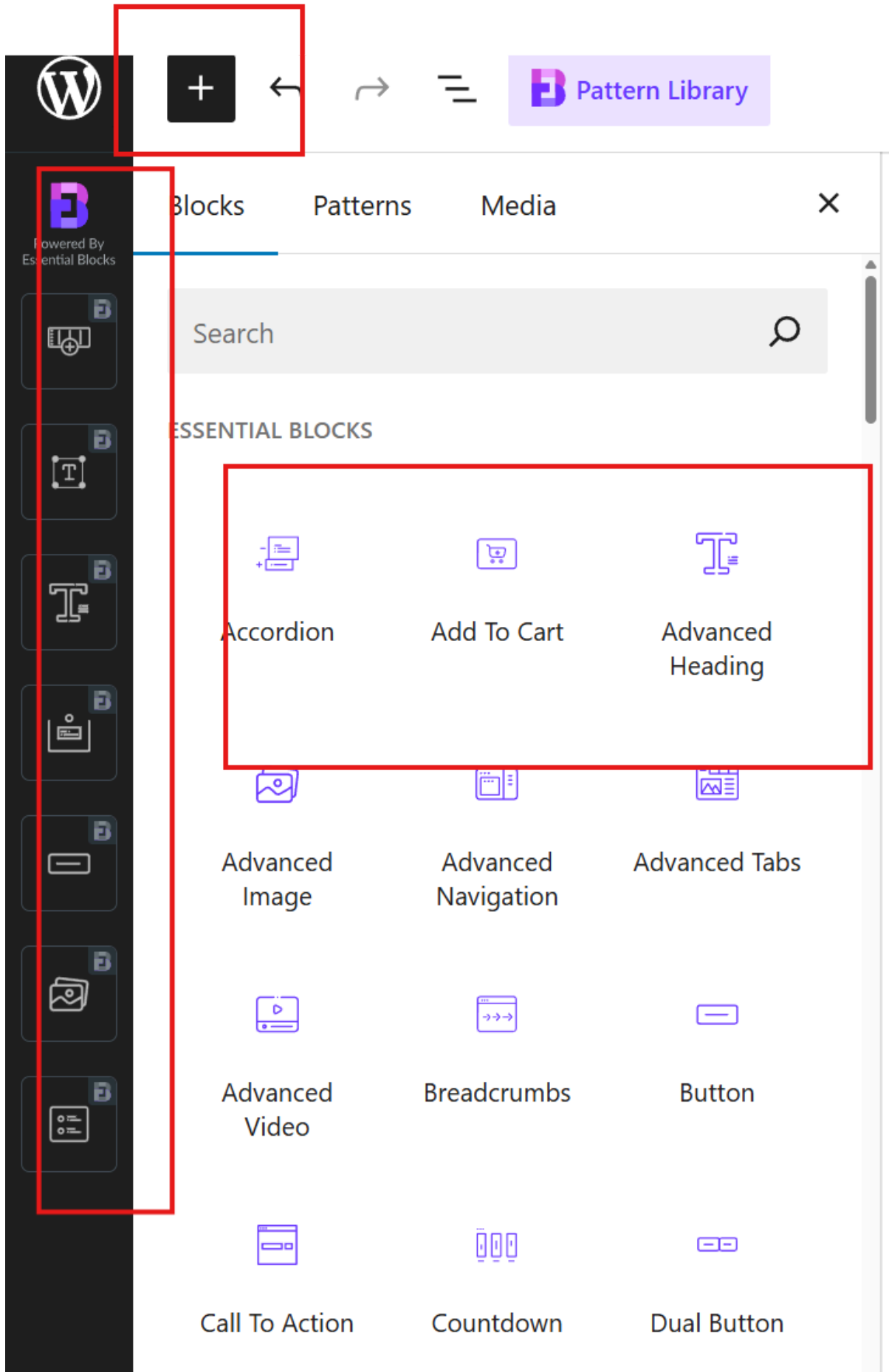


- Title it something like "Home"



- Use the Gutenberg editor to start building

To Use Essential Blocks:



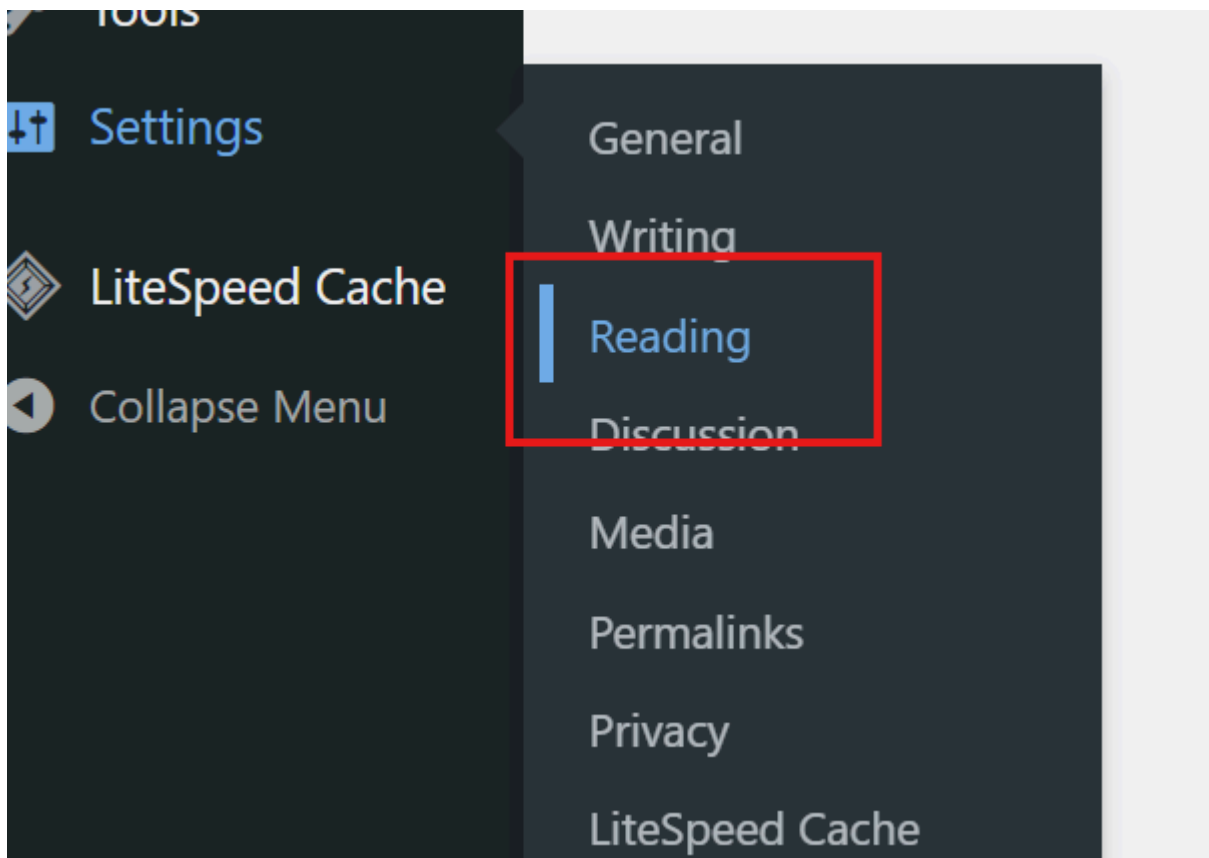
- Click the + icon to add a block
- Search for “EB” or “Essential Blocks”
- Add blocks like:
 - EB Advanced Heading
 - EB Button
 - EB Image
 - EB Call to Action

🎯 *Experiment freely – no code needed.*

- Click **Publish** when done


9. 🏠 Set Your Page as the Homepage

- Go to **Settings > Reading**



- Under “Your homepage displays”, select:
 - **A static page**

- Choose your “Home” page
